A. Subject: 2014 Hawaii Legislative Bills:

Of the companion sets of bills introduced by the Administration, to update provisions of the Hawaii Insurance Code relating NAIC model laws that are part of the NAIC accreditation standards (specifically, primarily as they affect Hawaii-domiciled RRGs) Senate Bills 2820 and 2821 have crossed over and are now being considered in the House. The two companion House bills have been deferred. There has been some opposition to the insurance holding company system aspects of SB 2821, and decision-making by the House Committee on Consumer Protection and Commerce on that measure is scheduled for this afternoon.

B. Subject: Proposed Administrative Rules:

A subcommittee of the Legislative Committee met with Acting Captive Insurance Administrator, Sanford Saito and Holly Osumi, on March 4, 2014 to discuss the proposed changes to the administrative rules relating to captive insurance. Among the issues discussed were: 1) reporting by captive managers for reporting adverse financial conditions of captives; 2) stating exam and other regulatory fees; and 3) credit for reinsurance for RRGs. The Insurance Division will take the discussions and suggested changes under advisement. We expect to have another meeting with Sanford and Holly after they have had an opportunity to further consider our discussions and suggested revisions.

Matt Takamine reported that Administration bills are anticipated for submission to: 1) Update provisions of the Hawaii Insurance Code relating to NAIC model laws which are part of the accreditation standards. 2) Update Article 4A relative to the updated NAIC credit for reinsurance model act. Thus far, there are no Administrative Bill(s) introduced in the 2014 session of the Hawaii Legislature specifically with
captive insurance companies. We will monitor to see whether a bill is introduced to revise certain aspects of Article 19.
On December 17, 2013 a subcommittee of the Legislative Committee met with Acting Captive Insurance Administrator Sanford Saito to discuss proposed changes to the Hawaii Administrative Rules. License fees and exam fees were discussed at length in that meeting. Sanford requested that HCIC provide them with changes or suggested language for their consideration
HCIC's Annual 2014 Hawaii Legislative Briefing will be held on Wednesday, January 22, 2014 to inform and update the legislative community.
Danel Licari reported 2014 membership renewals figures, hotel benefit renewals, and the membership drive and new ideas to increase membership.
Jason Palmer reported the financial statements as of December 31. 2013, with a pro-forma budget FY 2014.
Scot Sterenberg reported that he met with Acting Captive Insurance Administrator Sanford Saito to coordinate 2014 event/seminars including: World Captive Forum, CICA, RIMs, a West Coast trip with the State of Hawaii, VCIA, Hawaii Captive Insurance Forum, and the Japan trip.
EC agreed that Paul Shimomoto as HCIC's Industry Liaison would utilize HCIC's reciprocal pass to CICA. Paul will also attend the domicile leadership roundtable as Chris Mertes is unable to attend CICA this year.
