Bruce is the Gordon A. Mac-Donald Professor of Volcanology at the University of Hawaii, the Hawaiian State Volcanolo-



gist and Science Director at the FEMA-funded National Disaster Preparedness Training Center at University of Hawaii. He was awarded the 2017 Thorarinsson Medal (The highest international award in volcanology) and is a Fellow of the Royal Society of New Zealand. His research focuses on the mechanisms of basaltic explosive eruptions from real-time data and he will be sharing exciting information about the Hawaii Island volcanic activity, including video and photographs.
